Trekking Permits, National Park and Conservation Area fees are not needed for Nepali citizens

TIMS is not needed for Nepali citizens, foreign guests invited by the Government of Nepal and authorities from diplomatic missions, holding an official letter

Trekking Permits are issued for groups of 2 persons and more. If you are a single trekker, you have to buy 2 permits
